The 2nd India Software Engineering Conference will be held in, Yashwantrao Chavan Academy of Development Administration (YASHADA), Pune, Feb 23-26. ISEC conference is the main yearly conference of the newly created Special Interest Group on Software Engineering, SIGSE (www.cse.iitd.ac.in/sigse/) of the Computer Society of India. Technical Sessions

From over 100 submissions received, a compact program of 12 full papers and 14 poster papers in different areas have been selected. The papers were selected by an International Program Committee. Proceedings will be published by ACM, and all papers will be in the ACM digital library.

Experience Report Papers

In this ISEC we have papers in this category to describe state-of-the-art in practice. From many sessions, 6 papers have been accepted by the Program Committee for presentation in the conference.
